- 2. STRONG/GALE FORCE WIND
- 3. SNOW/SLEET
- 4. TEMPERATURES WITH A CHILL FACTOR BELOW ZERO
- 5. ICE/GROUND FROST ON THE SURFACE OF THE COURTS
- 6. EXTREME POOR VISABILITY eg THICK FOG

SNA COMMITTEE WILL FOLLOW THE MET OFFICE WEATHER FORECASTS WHEN MAKING DECISIONS TO CANCEL GAMES

ADVANCED NOTICE WILL BE GIVEN TO CLUBS VIA THE CLUB CONTACT ON FRIDAY EVENING PRIOR TO WINTER LEAGUE GAMES WHEN THE FORECAST INDICATES THIS. ALTERNATIVELY IF A DECISION HAS TO BE MADE ON THE DAY OF THE LEAGUE IT WILL BE BY 8AM ON THE SATURDAY LEAGUES AND 5PM ON EVENING LEAGUES
